# Message



# Message

One of the key elements of good governance is the empowerment of democratic institutions so that people become real partners in decision making. After the successful conduct of Panchayat Elections in 2018, it was essential to reach out to the people for petting their valuable feedback for meeting the functioning of the democratic methodors as vibrant and meaningful institutions of governance.

With a view to reaching out to every nook and comer of Jamesu & Kashmir, the Government conceived Black to Vitage (B2V) programme. The first of its kind in Jamesu & Kashmir. The programme which was organized from June 20-27, 2019, scross at 4483 Panchayets locusted on energizing Panchayets, optioning feedback on delivery of povernment schemes/programmes, capturing specific economic potential and undertaking sessessment of needs of the vitages. People came out in droves to welcome the visiting officers and appreciated the intrative of the government. 

- A suggested activity acheduse has been prepared for the visiting officer. It shall be incumbent on the officer to ensure that at activities and elements mentioned in the schedule are carried outcovered fully.
- It The visiting officer shall hold a meeting with the Deputy Commissioner of the destrict before undertaking the village visit. During this meeting he will be briefed about the action taken on the insues raised in the previous Back to Village visit in June and shall also be given various booklats, flyors and analyses.
- III. Batiore undertaking the visit, officer must familiarise himsettherself with important schemes especially fagality schemes, rural income focused programmes and individual beneficiary oriented programmes e.g. PM-KssA, Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme and Backyard Poultry Scheme.
