

2.	Only 1% of the population is with out drinking water supply & most of the existing pipelines are require repair.
3.	Standard of Education was not upto the mark it requires continuous check by the concerned authorities
4.	Present irrigation schemes / Nalla khuls require repairs & additional water resources can also be tapped for irrigated land of the Panchayat
5.	There is no playground in the Panchayat as such it should be taken in to consideration to Channelize the energy of the youth. Lower Nandoli (Tharal) has the area for playground (along the local Nallah).
6.	Upgradation of High School Tharal to Higher Secondary School & Upgradation of a School to MS level at Dubai & at Nandoli.
7.	Fish Ponds in each ward, Horticulture Plots in each ward, Agriculture school, seed store, etc.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	People were complaining (Especially Youth) that Govt. has ignored our village & we still live in pre-independence era.
