L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
Ed.	1. (A) Head Master required at <u>H.S. Kheri</u> as the post is lying vacant for past 6 months. At <u>Chinore school</u> 02 No. Rooms are required as existing ones are in dilapidated condition.
P.W.D.	2. Black topping of Roads in Panchayat (17 kms as demanded in B2V1) is required as most of roads are vulnerable for traffic paying expenses village Kheri.
M.E.	3. Huge Water Shortage in Ward No. 5 & 6. New tube well needs to be constructed in Ward No. 5/6. A bro Tube well at Ward No. 4, the const. of which was abruptly stopped needs to be restarted.
P.D.	4. Transformers for Kheran Nallah, Palthan & Chinore required for better electrification. Electric poles 50 Nos. (as demanded in B2V1) are required as live wires are hanging dangerously at many places.
H.	5. 2 No. dispensaries are required in Bantalah & Kheri for proper health care benefits to whole Panchayat. Also a Veterinary centre required at Kheri as there are large herds of cattle which require better medication.
Transport	6. Public Transport / Motor Service on 02 routes ① Kc to Chinore ② Kc to Kheri (Demanded in B2V1)
Ed.	7. Mobile School (Seasonal Centre) at Kheri needs basic facilities as no furniture/tent is available there and students are forced to sit on ground in open.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	People demanded basic facilities like sufficient supply of water, adequate no. of electric poles for replacing the broken ones and motorable roads especially in Kheri which has dilapidated roads. Besides, One Complaint from the Sarpanch was that Ward No. 1 which is in close proximity of Municipality, has many unauthorized dumping points. It was demanded that <u>dumpbins</u> in line with municipality be provided in Panchayat at suitable places for storage/disposal of filthy waste. It will be a good step in the cleanliness of the area.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	The Govt. departments of the Panchayat are working well as per physical and financial resources available with them. Efforts made by the Govt. to strengthen Panchayats is quite visible and people at grass root level have been empowered. Further, 73rd amendment should be fully implemented in P.R.I.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
	(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	During my stay in Panchayat, it was found that basic facilities like water, electricity, roads need improvement. Health care facilities should be expanded and more centres should be opened in Panchayat for better distribution of health care. Public transport needs upgradation to reduce hardships of locals. Besides, there was a suggestion from Panchayat members that some funds be placed at the disposal of Panchayat and its members be empowered to use such funds in contingencies for the welfare of public.
