I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: Pending works mentioned previous B2V1 and B2V2 should be completed. Renovation/ Repairing of link lines in all the ward. Regular supply of drinking water in all the wards (blocks) of panchayat. Upgradation of housewives for better electricity supply. Monetary/ Job compensation for those families whose land comes under Rajput Nagar Dam Project. Scarcity of employees in PHE, PDD and education dept. More funds to be allotted for the execution of development works for the welfare of people.
II	Major/ urgent public demands that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: Most of the major/urgent public demands that were reflected earlier such as Requirement of Community facility Centre, Playground, upgradation of Rajput Nagar dam, for the school purpose, better provision/repairing for those people whose land comes under dam project, Panchayat Office building for animal husbandry dept, Adequate funds, despite the fact by Panchayat of panchayat, they are demanding for separate panchayat, better road connectivity in link lines in all the wards, to provide people still waiting for the response to mitigate the problem for their welfare.
