- 7). Acute Crisis of irrigation in non-rainy season.

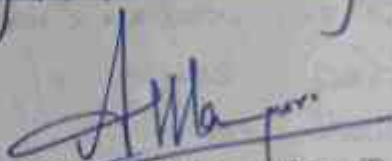
III Overall perception of functioning of the government.
