7. Closed Aanganwadi centre at Ichkoot to be re-established.

- (1) Complaint was brought by various forms of G.P. especially elder ladies/women that they have been kept in APL Ratio card holders despite being B.P.L., so a fresh survey be conducted and issue of needy be addressed.
