People of Pyl. Nelhew are living with Communal harmony & brotherhood. They brought few problems in my notice that for regular water supply, they need app. 500 water pipes, 150 electric poles for electrification of village, 03 transformers and they are facing problems to obtain Aadhar Cards & same should be prepared at Nelhew.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	After visiting, Govt. is very much serious about problems being faced by people of Pst. Velhew like Education of Children, health of people, employment for youth, many schemes for farmers, many schemes of villagers to get toilets, NREGA Job Cards, PMJJM, etc.

	Lastly, people of Pst. Velhew were not satisfied about pending liabilities related to schemes launched by Govt. & they show dissatisfaction over B2V1 for not assigning a single work during phase I for newly created Pst.
