



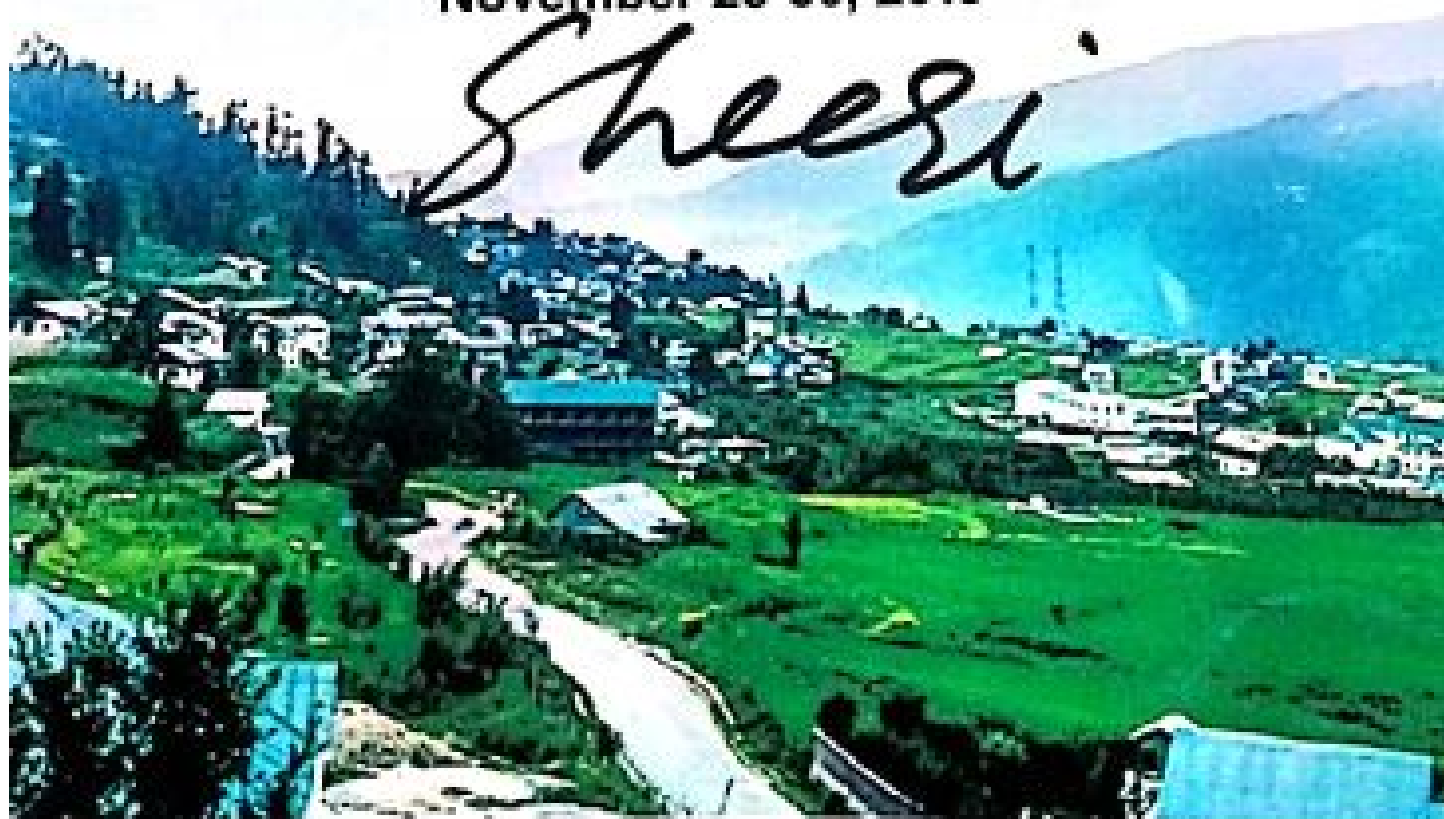

- 1. Flood & drought - for not providing protection band & river, Tehsil and Muzrai Nallah.
- 2. Education - because for not upgrading m/s school at M/s Nether is usually about 1000 m/s.
