(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

People have realized that B2V is a wonderful initiative of the Govt with its focus on employment at the doorstep.

During my visit I have observed that various depts have provided multiple structures in the same compound and have not used the land judiciously, which in turn has created land shape and scarcity of land for future development.

My suggestion would be to conduct dept wise audit of structures and rational planning of Govt to curb such menace viz viz corridor gardens in this particular GP.
