1. One playground at Kusan, Land already identified. Funds needed to the tune of Rs. 20.00 lacs for land clearing & fencing.
2. Drinking water supply. Funds needed for procurement of Distribution pipes 1" & 1/2" to the tune of Rs. 10.00 lacs.
3. Requirement of 100 H.T Poles & 150 L.T Poles & 6 km Aluminium wire. (Funds needed to the tune of Rs. 20.00 lacs).

4. Establishment & Construction of Dispensary (First Aid Center) at Badiberra for health coverage. Funds to the tune of 50 lacs required.

5. Construction of Panchayat Qabar needed. Funds to the tune of Rs. 50.00 lacs reqd. for casting PCI infrastructure.

6. Construction of public latrine, near public Sarow/ market & Majid Kusan. Funds reqd to tune of Rs. 10 lacs.

7. Demarcation/development of public park at Badiberra and Kusan. Funds to tune of Rs. 50.00 lacs, reqd.

ii. Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:

Majority of the Complaints were pertaining to lack of proper drinking water supply. Secondly whole of the area is facing very chronic shortage of electricity. This is majorly due to poor PDD infrastructure in place. Health related issues are very grave owing to lack of proper accommodation at PHC.

Still there is lot of gap between people in the village and those who provide services (Govt. officials). That gap needs to be bridged through proper awareness. Also more infrastructural facilities need to be created related to public service areas like health, education; drinking water supply and electricity.

Some of the issues raised during B.V. especially related to drinking water supply, electricity and health have not been resolved.
