 - Repair of pipes (PHE) lines & drain from ~~shel~~ to Lower Katar Mali is keen public demand.
 - PHE, along with staff & medicine is urgently required in Karyote Panchayat.
 - Land Development (levelling), protection work/water. Proper Drainage is keen public demand at various spots.
 - upgradation of middle schools and new primary school at upper Karyote Mali is urgently required.
 - Trailer roads / cattle shed / Passenger shed and B/Patt at various spots is urgently required.
 - Link Road from Karyote Mahalan Doh to Karyote Karaman a Transformer 63 kv is keen public demand of ward of Karyote Panchayat.
- Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
 - Public Transport due to poor road connectivity is major issue in the Panchayat (L.R)
 - PHE hasn't been established even after so many years
 - Panchayat Eshar hasn't been established in Karyote Panchayat
 - No high school has been established in the vicinity of the spot, so students have to travel long distance for their studies.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government

People of the Jammu Pakhalat in general is not satisfied with the implementation of various schemes developed by the government. In addition the Jammu Pakhalat has remained undeveloped due to ignorance by the Govt. (due to lack of awareness in the public)

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

The topography & location of the J.P. are such that the J.P. has remained neglected as well as undeveloped even if so many schemes implemented by the Govt. Suggestion:- Regular awareness camps along with proper road connectivity should be developed so that the public becomes more aware about various Govt. schemes and public infrastructure could be developed more easily.
