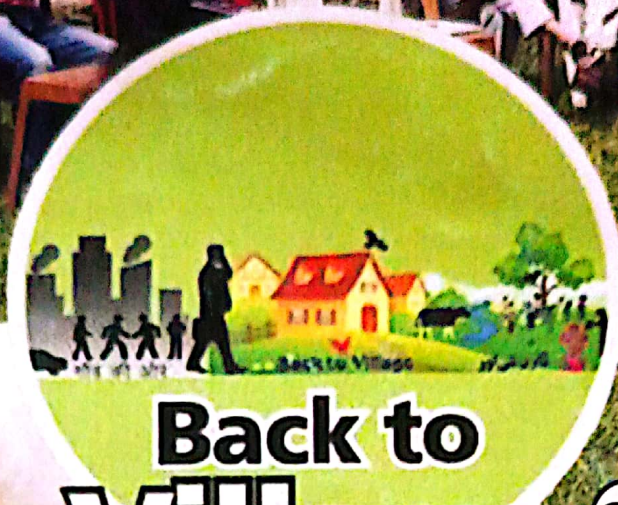

	Govt. has been selective about construction of the bathrooms under SBM (Saubhar Bharat Mission). The deserving people have not been allotted the bathrooms.

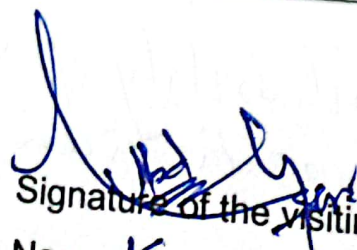
III Overall perception of functioning of the government:
