1.	Establishment of a health sub centre with at least one doctor and an ambulance.
2.	Construction of inner-roads ① From High school to Grampura ② From Shalimchalla to Bonidubnath ③ From Grampura to Bangadaji ④ Improvement of road from Bangadaji to village.
3.	Construction of a bridge at Nallab, Badli, Bhod S/o. Imberhat (most urgent).
4.	Construction of culverts at: ① Grampura nallab ② Bangadaji nallab ③ Wangra nallab ④ Some not 2 culverts from sub. mahalla to Bangadaji ⑤ From Bangadaji to Bangadaji A and B ⑥ Bonidubnath road no 7.
5.	Instead of hydroelectricity the household should be given solar inverters/light because the electric lines and poles get damaged due to heavy snowfall.
6.	Upgradation of Govt Middle School Grampura from middle school to High school.
7.	Construction of a water reservoir and supplying of piped water to every household.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	There is no health centre in the area. The nearest hospital (PHC) is almost 30 km away from Bonidubnath. As there are no inner roads and the area receives heavy snowfall during long winters, the patients particularly pregnant women are faced in distress.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

Though on papers, there are various departments functioning in the area but physically there are none. The employees are always on move, as there are no offices or buildings for these departments. Due to non-availability of mobile network, it becomes difficult to trace out these employees. Though they remain present in the area.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

The area is the most backward area lying at line of control and therefore needs a special care attention. The area has the high potential for tourism, fisheries and hydroelectricity. The schools face huge accommodation problems. Almost every middle school has only three rooms i.e., three rooms for eight classes and office, excluding nursery & lower prep classes.
