	Urgent and long pending demand of better Road Connectivity from 1. Manepathur to Budmambal. Connecting the place through a Tunnel would be a one time solution for all time to come.
	2. Lack of Electricity. The place is yet to see electricity till date, even in 21st Century. Underground Cable would be a one time solution for all times. Till then providing Solar water pumps is desirable.
	3. Connectivity in term of Telephone/mobile/internet facilities. Rudimentary tele connectivity through mobiles is available but nothing beyond that.
	4. Drinking water supply / Irrigation water supply.
	5. Non Availability of Medical and Health infrastructure both Manpower and infrastructure wise.
	6. Setting up of Employment Generating centres.
	7. Recreation and Entertainment Zones: playgrounds, Parks etc.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	All weather Road Connectivity remains the major problem faced by the population of this place. A place of more than 6000 population is connected to the outer world through a slender road which is difficult and gets becomes unmovable during winters. (our team of BV2 officers walked nearly 10 kms in knee deep snow to reach here after our 4x4 vehicles failed to move). Building / Digging a Tunnel was a demand from several elders.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	Overall perception about the functioning of government is satisfactory, but there are few complaints regarding accountability, transparency and so far as the good governance is concerned.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	This beautiful place is placed in an unwholesome dis -geographic location. Most of the people live ^{Below} under poverty level conditions. Most of the basic amenities of life are lacking ranging from roads, electricity, Mobile connectivity, Internet, Banking facilities. Non-local Govt. functionaries find it very difficult to be here under such conditions. Strengthening of Educational and youth empowering institutions is strongly recommended, which in the long run can solve most problems at the local level itself.
