II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer: *
The residents of the Panchayat complained about the non-implementation of assessment done during B2V. The people there are dissatisfied about the practicality of theoretical assessment done during the B2V programme. The people also complained about the non-operation and non-functionality of some departments like Revenue, horticulture, fisheries, Soil Conservation, Tehsil Social welfare. My urgent request	

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is to stress upon the people's complaints, so that people will develop taste about such programmes in future and grass root governance.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

The functionality of govt. and panchayat level may be good. People have shown more interest about the system of governance at panchayat level. But the functionality of govt. will get stronger when authorities at higher level will cooperate with the locals. The functioning of govt. at local level is showing improvement and people are showing interest in B2V program.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

The people have become aware about the local governance and the power sharing has helped people at local level to improve their living. Their participation in the B2V program states how much interested they are to get connected with the governance at higher levels. But people will remain vested in such governance and programme when it will show its practicability.

Suggestions:-

1. The practicability of theoretical assessment done in two series of B2V programmes. ② The authorities at higher level should cooperate with the govt. at local level, as people mostly complain against the authorities like Revenue, social welfare department etc.
- ③ The power share at local level should be given reality and it will come to surface, when the grievance heard will get implemented. (4) In order to keep people interested in future programmes of B2V series and hopeful about local governance, the practicability of programme and governance is important. Otherwise people will get distasteful in future. So to give real shape to these programmes, again stress upon the authorities to implement programmes in concrete ways, so that people will show interest to get connected with state. Their hope is state and state should remain concerned in practical terms.
