7.	Construction of Animal for Husbandry for Turbana
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
1)	Construction of Bridge connecting Kachan to Turbana since 1999
2)	Construction of Port Bridge of Kachan Road

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

The proposals which were taken in P.V. have not been implemented at ground level and people are disappointed when all the work at ground level are not being completed on due time.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

The parastatal institutions with experience are active and ready to work for the welfare of the people with zeal.

The overall functioning of parastatals is satisfactory. There should be sufficient funds at parastatal level for execution of work properly. Proper health facilities are lacking, people demand the local animal husbandry Centre.
