

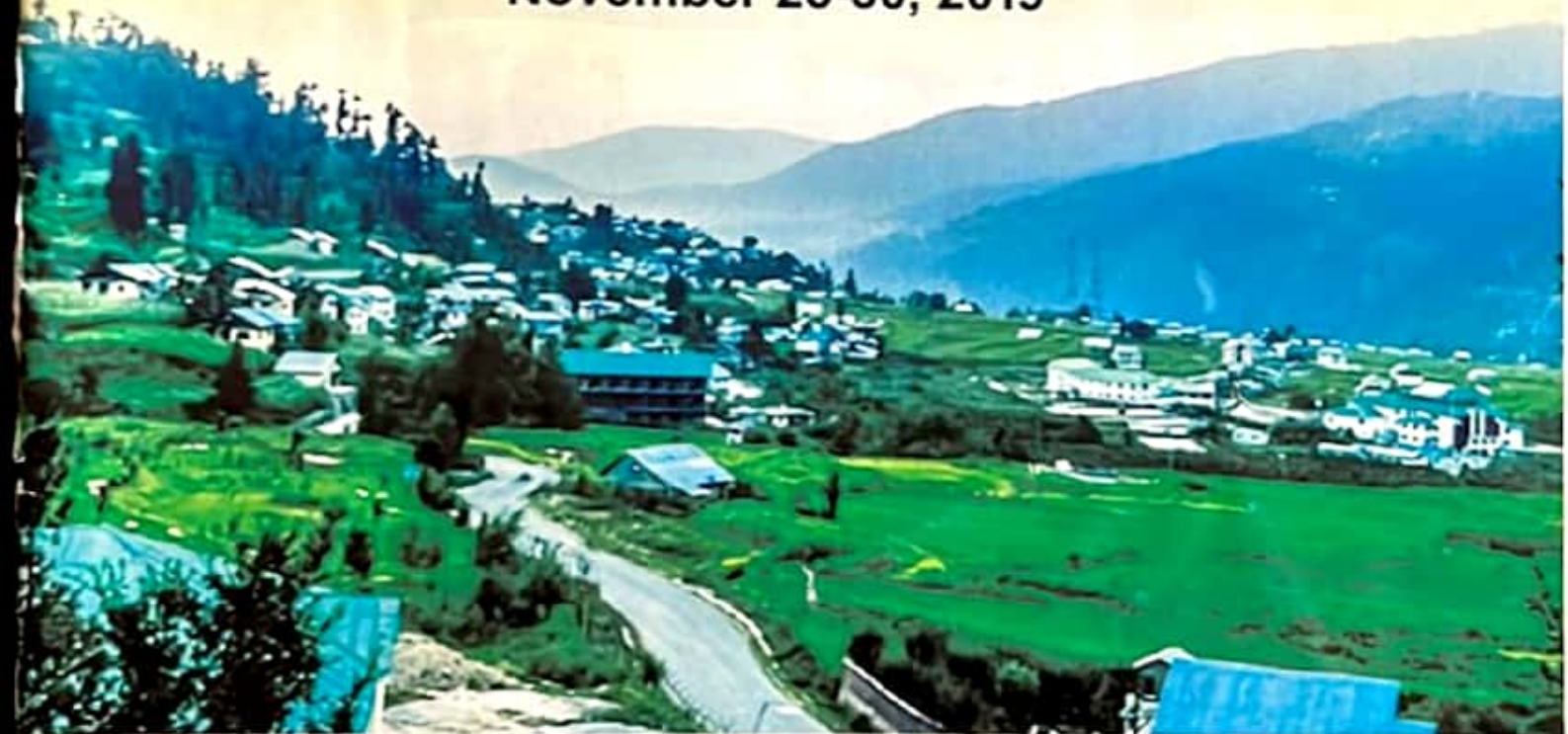

L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):

1. Construction of a new overhead Tank (OHT) & replacement of old water pipes which have rusted hence are hazardous to health.

2. Replacement of HT, LT poles & wires at priority. old poles are mostly of wood & many can collapse at any time. Also wires are hanging at low levels. All this can something lead to a disaster.

3. There is no health facility available in E.P. An area of more than 3000 definitely should have atleast one health sub centre.

4. Schools existing in the E.P either have no compound walls or have inadequate compound walls. In order to secure schools compound walls should be constructed on priority. Schools should be provided with ICT facility, sports equipments & fire proof vaults. Also trees in the compound of schools should be cut as some can lead to some untoward incident.

5. The concerned E.P has no play ground at all. There is an immediate need to demarcate land for the same & construct it.

6. Attahal road should be completed on war-footing basis. Also there should be widening & develop of Hadipna - Achhal road & Achhal chokher road through R&B. Link roads also need improv.

7. There are many deserving poor people in the area. Social welfare dept should be given direction to do a survey immediately & identify & help the deserving cases like poor, old age, handicapped etc.

II Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:

- All govt level departments aren't providing awareness about govt schemes effectively.
- There are many complaints about faulty wiring & trees supply HT lines.
- Lanes are very narrow & there is no proper drainage available.
- Lack of playgrounds.
- ICDS centres don't have things to keep things. Also nothing has not been provided to them. Also they don't have any health facility.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	<p>The inhabitants of R. Pore devoid of many basic facilities - But at the same time we should appreciate the functioning of ICDS centres even though they are not being paid for that also. The panchayat there is properly maintained & credit must be given to the Sarpanch. At the same time we must appreciate the ever-energetic VAO of the area, the enthusiastic A.R.S. & committed Chowkidar of Panchayat there. They all must be encouraged by incentivising their work.</p>
