4.	Upgradation of health dispensary to primary health centre.
5.	Re-wiring, overhaul & repair of electric poles & wires, which is under Panchayat since B2V2, should be completed as soon as possible.
6.	Beate Subba, a habitat of the Panchayat, has been taken out of the jurisdiction of Panchayat & be allotted to Mahalinga. Beate Subba & Panchayat should be merged.
7.	One of the former GPs & in near vicinity with Panchayat should be built out of Panchayat. Panchayat should be asked to open an extension centre in Beate Subba.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:

→ Pending regarding release of funds in PM Awas yojna / Shiksha Shiksha - Tolls Disproportionate allocation of MNRGA job cards.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
