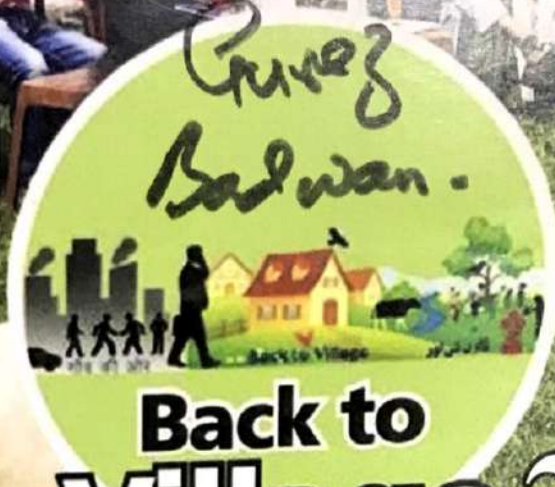




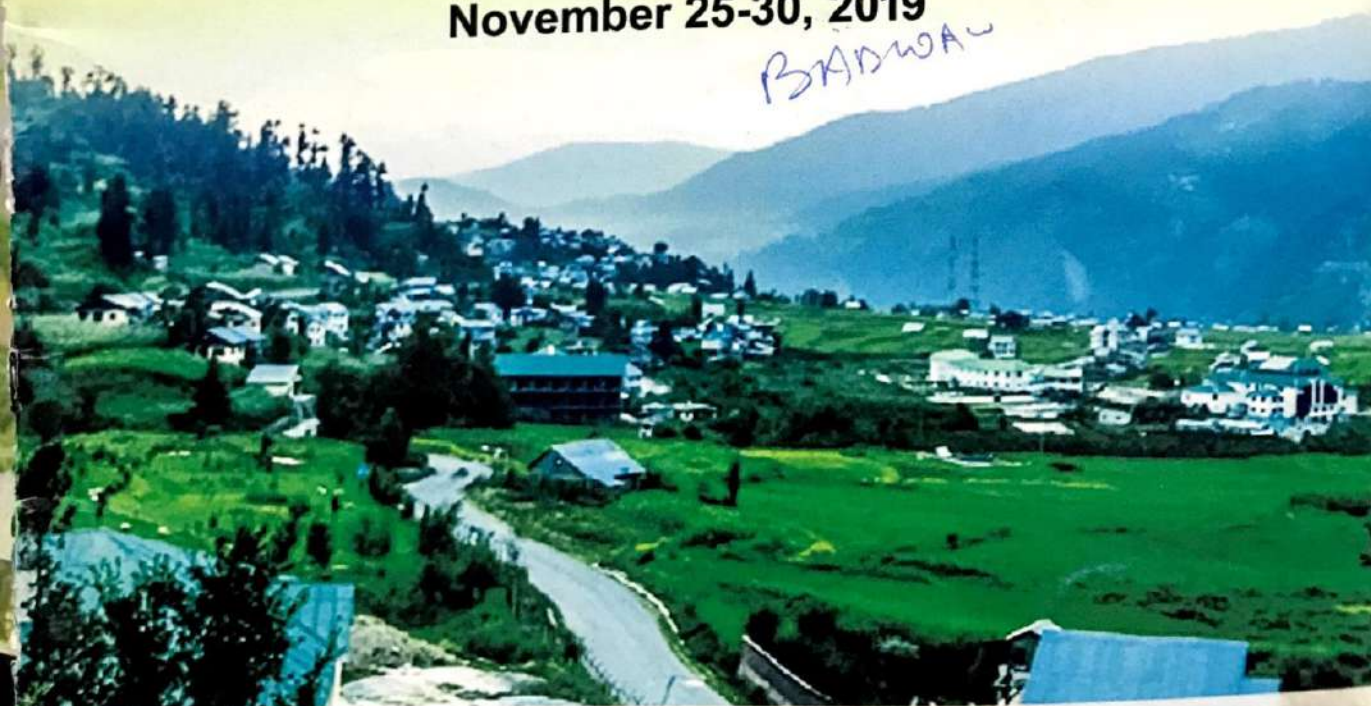

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

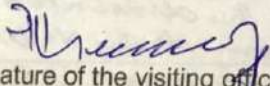

The problems or demands which I have recorded in this booklet are extracted after a thorough discussion with the people of the concerned Panchayat Talga and the information collected from the frontline workers of diff. depts. As we know there is lack of awareness among the people as well as among the village level representatives about different welfare schemes of Govt. being a farflung hilly Tehsil where the

workseason here is very limited of not more than 5 months therefore it requires timely approval and estimation of diff. works and timely release of funds so that the projects or works taken up can be completed
