L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
	Faizabad - Chedpora water supply Scheme be completed by all respects and every household be connected with taps so that people may overcome drinking water crisis.
	2. Play-ground over state land of about 100 kanals be constructed immediately.
	3. Gugloosa (A) is highly flood-prone area for the floods through Nallah Kehmil so immense need is to construct Bunde on both sides of Kehmil particularly hamlet Kulpara (W-7) is on severe threat.
	4. Kulpara (W-7) totally isolated from main Panchayat (1 1/2 km) is without school, dispensary and food-center (building) and (damaged work).
	5. Animal and sheep husbandry center be sanctioned to promote dairy and live-stock sectors.
	6. Schools in Gugloosa (A) are without drinking water and fencing which needs to be provided immediately and also EMS & BMS required urgent repairing.
	7. Construction of Flumes for most of the agricultural areas of which the canals have been washed off by the floods of Nallah Kehmil.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	Besides being located between the two power receiving stations one at Trehgam and another at Kulpara, the Panchayat is still connected with Kupwar (Tikka) power stations. So need is to either sanction of a new receiving station or Trehgam be upgraded and this village be connected with it or should be connected with Kulpara. In addition poles and wires are totally outdated which needs to be renovated as L.T.s are not on poles at many of the places where they are attached with scuffs.

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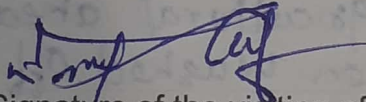
III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

There is no effect of Govt seen on ground at the Panchayat as per the views of Public except some mere developmental process executing through RDD which is always a routine exercise of every govt. No such projects are being started which could enhance the economic condition of Panchayat.
