The overwhelming public participation which was seen in B2V, was missing and people showed resentment perhaps after seeing the progress report and unchanged scenario in on ground execution and grievance redressal to their claims and demands put forth in B2V. These villages should be visited to, in which there is a visible change in order to gain the trust of people so that there is participation of people for good governance and development. People's will should be the basis for the visit in any particular area, otherwise it remains again a formality.
