6.	Panchayat Khadi need fencing and a green building along with completing of Community facility Centre building.
7.	Fire force shop for wardal with lockdown.
II. Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:	
The Anganwadi workers are underpaid despite playing a vital role in the development of future generation. The centres have no Govt. building. They don't have proper furnishing and heating system which makes them unusable during winter. Further the nutritious food items are not provided to them.	

B Overall perception of functioning of the government

Average citizen is unaware of the policies and programmes of the govt. departments. The panchayat is the headquarters of the school and majority of the departments have not been started at the school headquarters.

e.g. Horticulture, social welfare, financial, land survey, health, school Education Office, child medical medical office and PHS substation.

C Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

1. The Commissioner requested to see for himself the working of the Health Centre which in fact is dysfunctional without the basic necessities.

2. Most of the offices of govt. depts. are understaffed though posts are vacant in some cases.

3. The offices of some depts. to open in the village as the H.Q. is in the school so that people can approach them for help and guidance.
