I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
	<p>The Panchayat halqa has acute shortage of drinking water. Capacity of old reservoir at Guggar pati should be increased. There is huge demand & supply gap of drinking water.</p>
	<p>Replacement of old and damaged L.T line & poles. It needs immediate redressal as LT wires poses threat to life & property hanging on trees.</p>
	<p>Establishment of primary health centre as PH has. Sub centre that is running in a rented room. Basic minimum infrastructure is not available.</p>
	<p>Soil erosion is common in Guggar, pati malla. The area needs special attention regarding soil conservation programmes.</p>
	<p>One of the reason of water crisis is old & damaged water pipes. Huge quantity of water gets leaked because of damaged pipes. Replacement programme on part of PHE Division should be started.</p>
	<p>Total number of host schools in PH is 08. Fencing of boundary walls of schools should be started. Schools have toilet facilities but are non functional because of non availability of water supply. Boundary wall of M. school Guggar pati should be priority as there are chances of attack on students by wild life.</p>
	<p>7. Irrigation canal kalkul near PH needs repairment. rain harvesting projects, has potential in the area.</p>
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	<p>Major complaints brought to my notice during the visit are about unsafe and inadequate drinking water. The reservoirs of the area should be updated & capacity should be increased. People are facing acute shortage of safe & pure drinking water; old & damaged pipes are in disrepair condition. Condition of electrical lines & poles is worse. L.T. are hanging on poplar & willow trees. The reservoir functioning in the area has only 20000000 capacity which is insufficient to feed the whole area.</p>

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	Overall perception about the functioning of government is satisfactory. The major areas where government needs to take immediate steps are electricity and water supply. People of the PHU have heartedly welcomed the B2V1. People have high hopes with these programmes to get their demands full filled. It was observed that these events should be held frequently.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
	(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	Drinking water is not available in sufficient quantity. New Scheme should be launched in 4 P. Electricity infra structure should be updated & replaced. Creation of Pry. Health Centre is required.
