

7	Fixation of a wide-culvert at am-nod where the previous one is very narrow which causes water logging on the other side and hence causes severe damage to orchids and residential-houses
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	Agricultural fertilizers, chemicals and pesticides are sub-standard which causes less production and consequently, less income to farmers. Moreover, though the health-centre is available here but without basic facilities. No medicine is available here, no medical tests are being done here, which often push patients to go miles away for their treatments.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government.

People are fed-up to the core with the functioning of the government. They are being tantalized, hoodwinked and deceived. Nothing is being done whatever is promised to them by the government. If anything is done, that is done at snail's pace.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions.

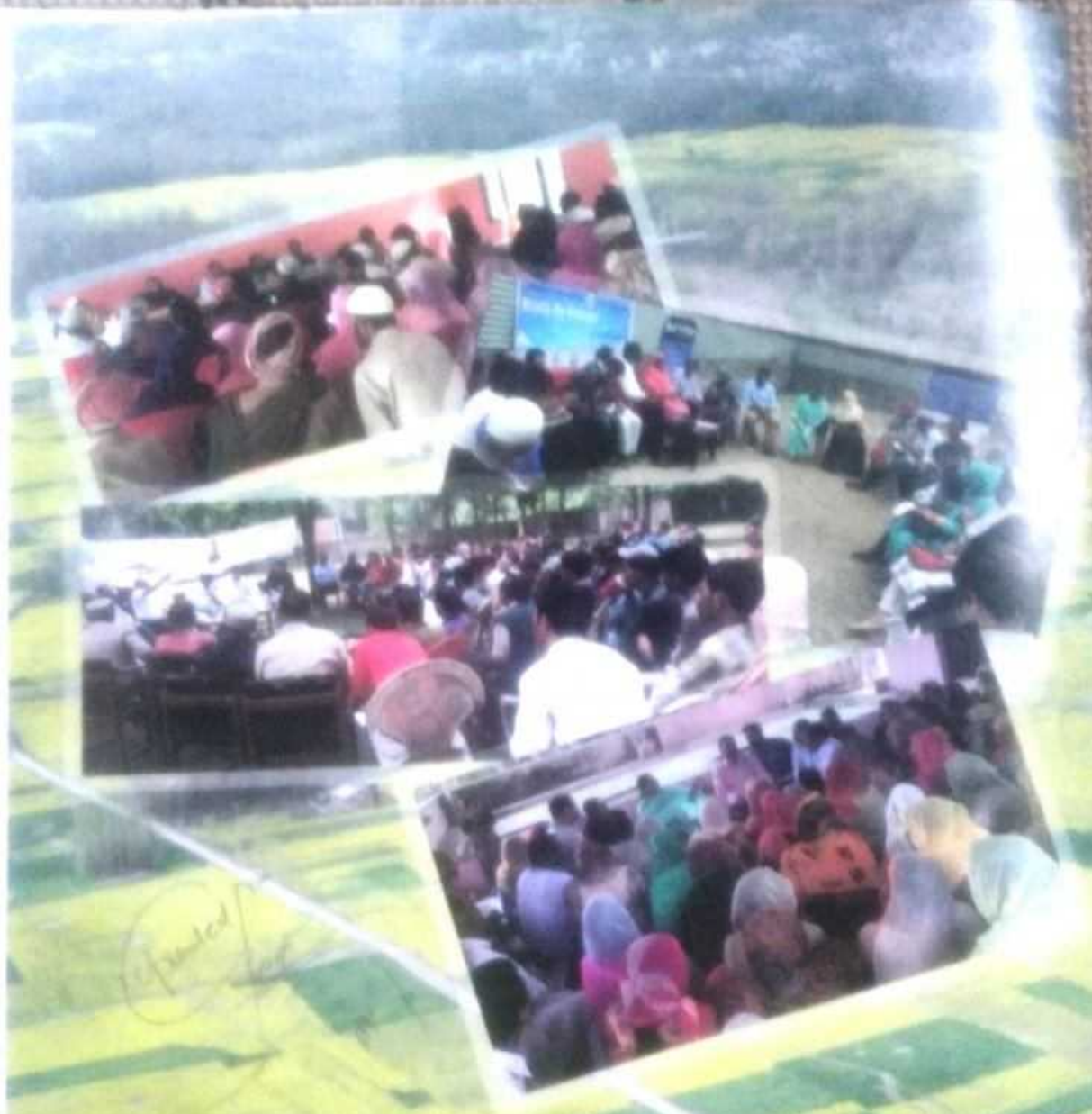
