	<p>① IAY cases registered are still pending due to lack of funds</p> <p>② 150 Electric poles (LT) are immediately needed for smooth electric supply to Halqa.</p> <p>③ Elected Panch complains that Jsk Police and Army don't cooperate with Panchayat.</p> <p>④ All of the govt. land, including school premises are filled with cardamom, a blot on "Swachh Bharat mission" and on the concerned officials of the Halqa.</p>

The Govt. departments are functioning well especially RDO, PDD and PHB. Other departments need further improvements to meet the standard.


IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
