

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	Safe drinking water, water filtration plant for which 40 no. (4 inch) pipes are needed, water connectivity from Phase I-II. Need of one additional watered reservoir and bore well.
2.	Reverse electricity connectivity, needs poles (30 no.) for about 148 hectares, removal of HT lines from local trees/populus, at least 3 transformers (250 KV) needed.
3.	Ward No. 3, 4 and 5 need separate Anganwadi centres
4.	Proper modernization of 3 link roads from main road (around 7 kms). The condition of roads is very worst.
5.	One Primary health centre building (at least 3-4 rooms), one doctor and Ambulance.
6.	Upgradation of Primary school to Middle school as around 200 pupil are school going students in the village
7.	127 households need Pucca House under PMAY (SECC / Non SECC)
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	Major problem of the village is drainage system. There is a major problem of drainage in the whole Jalshevi village which needs proper attention from the higher ups. So that further damage in the village may be stopped.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	Major population around 70% are laborers in the village with very miserable conditions. People have lot of expectations from the government but, unfortunately people in the village are getting little response from the government and all concerned government departments.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
i.	The overall assessment of Panchayat functionaries have been found satisfactory. The Panchayat Committee / senior citizens are working together for the overall progress and development of Panchayat Halaya Jaldeesi.
