	The major complaint about officers and officials were brought. The only issue raised was non-completion of all the works identified earlier - BIV & BIIV. The issue of water supply was raised repeatedly which will be settled under JAM.

	Water Supply issue remains on top of the mind of public. The issue is being addressed under JAM but will take time to fully cover the Parahyati area.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions. (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions)
	The visit evoked very enthusiastic response from Public. The participation in Sabha was big despite the harvesting season. Overall the public was satisfied with functioning of the officials & departments and access of officials to public. The demands are few more in number and resources are limited. The functioning of Mahila Sabha & awareness about various Sanchayi Karyakarshaks was quite good.
