GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer

Condition of roads is very poor, drinking water supply station is not proper due to old dist. network & shortage of staff. Also Social welfare dept. has not provided any assistance/guidance to locals for old age pension, widow pension, disability pension and other welfare schemes. Medical dispensary is located on one end of Pst. Badali and locals don't prefer to go there as Udhampur Town is also approachable so new building of Health & Welfare Center should be constructed in the centre location of Pst. Badali. Need of Veterinary dispensary is also required in Pst. Badali.

Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far

- 1) Shifting of dispensary (Health) must be shifted to centrally located place of Panchayat Badali as existing building is in dilapidated condition.
- 2) Requirement of minimum ten No handpumps in various wards and one number Borewell/tube well is also required.
- 3) Spring Sours - 02 No. have been cut off due to Const. of boundary wall by Jh Police Academy and locals are demanding for taking spring sour out of boundary wall.
- 4) Construction of various new roads in Panchayat Badali — a) Road to Panchayat Ghat/Highschool b) Nalmon to Manpa c) Road from Primary school to Vardhaman Mahalaxi etc, Macadamization/blacktopping of existing road, drainage work along existing roads.
- 5) Requirement of new transformers at WNO 1 Manpa, WNO 4 & 5 Raj's Mandali & Ward No 103, Upgradation of existing transformers, New poles — approx 66 Nos. replace of damaged poles & conductor.
- 6) Paving, Boundary wall & repair/renovation of existing High School building and Panchayat

The Panchayat Badali comprises of two No villages — Badali & Manpa about 7-8 km from District Head Quarter between Devika River & Birwan Nallah having about 2000 Population and very few families have agricultural land and some families have livestock — cows, buffaloes etc. But most of the Population depends upon other source of income like — business, jobs, skilled labour & unskilled labour. The major Problem of the public as mentioned in Major Complaints & Public demands is construction of major & minor roads, tractor roads, proper drainage system along existing road, repair of existing road, Construction of lane drains, Proper drinking water facility i.e. Piped water supply & requirement of handpumps, rural electrification also lacks in some parts of Pst. Badali i.e. No Electric poles are needed, replacement of damaged poles & conductor, new transformers are also needed. The overall assessment of Pst. Badali is that in some areas basic amenities are not fully delivered to the public and needs urgent intervention of our Government for making their livelihood easy & happy
