a) more than 100 Nos of factories such as Cement units, pesticides units and PPF etc have been installed in our Pgt Khrooni and generating major pollutions/affecting our agriculture, fish culture and living environment as well.

b) Apart from above, our SSSI & High Schools are too badly affecting, delays are:-

Needless to state that pollution of factories have not only badly effected environment of nearby schools but to badly effected our Agriculture Sector, Sericulture Sector, & Handicrafts Sector etc., this resulted in very difficult to survive many border such crises.

So, it is our humble request to look into the issue personally and all these factories may please be shifted. In case shifting of factories not possible that peoples surrounding of industry area may be migrated to a safe place. In the mean-while necessary compensation on a/c of non production of crops in our land may please be chalked out and paid to effected peoples to avoid further harassment.

Further, being Villagers our basic profession is only agricultural, Sericultural, Handicrafts etc, the same have now totally stopped due to major pollution of factories and become very difficult to survive many border such a huge pollution.

Till the time. Shifting to safe location is not carried out as well as compensation of crops of our land is too not paid, our all members from each family may please be given the opportunity to move in the factories, so that our life / survival may not further effected.

Apart from the above, too submitted that our most of the peoples are becoming victim of diseases, which quite unjustly harm our peoples. Rest all factories have based their own hand pump and wash out their waste water which has effecting to our natural water, only source of drinking water. Request issue necessary direction is all concerned to control all such wash out water at this end avoid throwing wash out to Nallaha etc.

Since all said factories have based their hand pump and washing the water, this not only resulted in shortage of water in surrounding of our area but has polluted our natural sources. May look into the issue and direct the practice of washing / throwing waste of water to nearby Nallaha etc.

Due to day night flowing of water in hand pump of factories our surrounding hand pump have stopped yielding water and our become abtmanpl.
