## Message

I am delighted to learn that the 3<sup>rd</sup> version of the much-acclaimed *Back to Village-3 (B2V3)* programme, a unique and ambitious exercise of taking government to the doorstep of people is being organized from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020, across Jammu & Kashmir.

In June 2019, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir embarked on the *Back to Village* programme, which involved the visit of over 4000 Gazetted officers of J&K to every Panchayat and spending two days and a night there. It was also an opportunity to support and strengthen the newly constituted Panchayats. The programme was a huge success. Visiting officers were welcomed and feted by populace eager to share its troubles and travails with what they had perceived as an unresponsive administration. In fact such was the enthusiasm generated by the programme that the Hon'ble Prime Minister made a mention of it in his "Man Ki Baat", calling it "a festival of development, public participation and public awareness."

Encouraged by the success of the programme, the government organized the *Back to Village-2 (B2V2)* in November 2019. This time the focus was on ensuring that funds and functions devolved to the Panchayats were used without any bottlenecks and that beneficiary oriented schemes actually reach the last person in the queue. The Hon'ble Prime Minister again made mention of the programme in his Independence Day speech of 2020.

I believe the upcoming version of the *Back to Village-3 (B2V3)* programme will be an attempt at a concentrated and determined developmental push in the region. The actual programme shall be preceded by a three week Jan Abhiyan (Awami Muhim) which shall focus on 3 concurrent and interconnected goals: Jan Sunvwai (Awami Sunwai) - Public grievances redressal, Adhikar Abhiyan (Muhim Barai-e-Haqooq) - Public Service Delivery and Unnat Gram Abhiyan (Dehi Taraqiyyati Muhim) - Delivery of Development on ground.

I am confident that this unique effort shall earn the respect of the people of Jammu and Kashmir and that it will be remembered for long as a unique and sincere effort of the government to reach the doorsteps of the people.

Dept., PHE Dept. Because of that whole Panchayat suffered a lot. Panchayat Ghar and kitchen shed of high School damaged by PWD Dept but till not get compensation. Social welfare Dept doesn't show any responsibility towards Public about their schemes.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: → Road connectivity in ward no 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 → under constructed Panchayat Ghar and PHC. → Poles, wires, transformers → Non availability of water shed Dept → Repairing of Damage water pipes and water reservation tanks → Protection wall along the Nalla Rased Chanyloo in whole Panchayat → Foot Bridges, Culvert, Drainage system need to be repair → Repairment of Damage schools, Boundary wall in all schools.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.) The Panchayat is functioning well and P.R.I's members are well aware of their duties, but the villagers does not show any response due to works not done during B2V1 and B2V2. General awareness is important for Public. All concerned Department is needed to provide basic amenities and address their grievances. Most of the Dept doesn't show any interest. There is a lot of scope for development and economic potential which needed to be exploited and I requested to least concerned Dept to kindly look into the matter and solved their problems.
