
Overall assessment of visit and suggestions
(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

1. Most of the public issues raised during B2V1 & B2V2 have not been resolved as reported and also spotted by the V.O. which is the main cause of boycott by the PRIs of Panchayat Halqua Mandi Kehli Samba as per reports received.
2. A major problem with the Panchayat is the overflow of water during rainy season in lane from Govt. Model HSS (Boys) to Mandir Wali upto Army Camp wall Gali. During the rainy season, water enters into the houses of the residents. Even sand and small stones have also damaged the lane as spotted by the visiting officer. Hence, this is a great/big issue to resolve.
3. Moreover, during COVID-19 period, the people of the Panchayat are found well aware of wearing masks, wash up hands frequently and maintaining social distancing.
4. Some people have welcomed the B2V Programme and suggested for conducting it frequently after one or two months for the redressal of public demands.

The Back to Village Programme 3 was conducted on 6/10/2020 to 8/10/2020 at Panchayat Mandi Keli Samba. All the officials/officers of various departments remained present in the Programme except Social Welfare & Food & Supply Departments. All the officers & officials were very much co-operative at all ends. Some of them displayed the items and made the people aware of the various schemes launched by these departments. Dr. Priyanka Gandhi of Health Deptt & Smt. Sarita Sharma of ICDS Deptt highlighted the precautions to be adopted during Pandemic COVID-19 and about the nutrition to be fed by the mothers to their children from the age of birth to the age of Adolescence period. Some of the grievances of the people were resolved by the deptts. concerned on the spot. The BDC Chairperson Smt. Kamlesh Kuma along with Prominent Citizens also participated and raised 10 issues (file enclosed) and demanded their early redressal. But All-the PRI members boycotted the Programme.
