## Message

I am delighted to learn that the 3<sup>rd</sup> version of the much-acclaimed Back to Village-3 (B2V3) programme, a unique and ambitious exercise of taking government to the doorstep of people is being organized from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020, across Jammu & Kashmir.

In June 2019, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir embarked on the Back to Village programme, which involved the visit of over 4000 Gazetted officers of J&K to every Panchayat and spending two days and a night there. It was also an opportunity to support and strengthen the newly constituted Panchayats. The programme was a huge success. Visiting officers were welcomed and feted by populace eager to share its troubles and travails with what they had perceived as an unresponsive administration. In fact such was the enthusiasm generated by the programme that the Hon'ble Prime Minister made a mention of it in his "Man Ki Baat", calling it 'a festival of development, public participation and public awareness.'

Encouraged by the success of the programme, the government organized the Back to Village-2 (B2V2) in November 2019. This time the focus was on ensuring that funds and functions devolved to the Panchayats were used without any bottlenecks and that beneficiary oriented schemes actually reach the last person in the queue. The Hon'ble Prime Minister again made mention of the programme in his Independence Day speech of 2020.

I believe the upcoming version of the Back to Village-3 (B2V3) programme will be an attempt at a concentrated and determined developmental push in the region. The actual programme shall be preceded by a three week Jan Abhiyan (Awami Muham) which shall focus on 3 concurrent and interconnected goals: Jan Sunwai (Awami Sunwai) - Public grievances redressal, Adhikar Abhiyan (Muham Barai-e-Haqooq) - Public Service Delivery and Unnat Gram Abhiyan (Dehi Tarajiyati Muham) - Delivery of Development on ground.

I am confident that this unique effort shall earn the respect of the people of Jammu and Kashmir and that it will be remembered for long as a unique and sincere effort of the government to reach the doorsteps of the people.

Whereas, in terms of land acquisition requirement of Department of Higher Education to setup a College in Block Rampur, the District administration after a deep search and consultation with various stakeholders and feasibility & availability of state land, concluded that the available land in Panchayat Rani can shall be transferred to the Higher Education department for setting up the institution.

Whereas, after carrying out a detailed deliberations, the District administration in consultation with the higher education department and SDM Vijaypur, initiated the process of laying of foundation stone for the Degree College in Panchayat Rani few days ago.

Therefore, the Government of J&K laid a foundation stone for setting up a college in the vicinity of the Rani which is part of Block Rampur in Sub division of Vijaypur.

Now, to derail the process of setting up a college in the State Land demarcated by the revenue authorities, the land mafia and illegal encroachers of this state land had approached the District Administration and pressurized not to setup the college in this area citing the fake public demand.
