I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
-	Road from Jugal Bells to Topa is under construction for more than 3 years, 1.2 km of road construction is completed but the remaining 1.3 km of road construction is not running properly due to some dispute due to water people's anger & etc. Lack of water supply due to non-availability of heavy motor for water system. Improper supply of electricity and need of road connectivity to different areas. Every person visits to Pandeyat from different departments & always promises to work but nothing has been done. Water tank constructed by Mohd Hussain is 10.07, but still not filled.
II	Major/ urgent public demands) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: Water supply problem in different wards, water tanks required in wards of Pandeyat. Tractor road in ward no 02, 05, 07 & 09. Toilet complex in school's new construction & renovation also. Toilet complex in mosque Need of transformer in ward no 01 of 63 KV & 25 KV is already installed and also new transformer needed in ward no 06 & 06. In ward no 06 & 06. Green grass boundary wall in ward no 02. PWS water tank repairing in ward no 08.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions)
-	Toilet complex are needed in Anguward, Cantt & road side school. Road connectivity is needed in Pandeyat different areas. Water supply is not proper due to leakage of pipes, need of 1000 H.P motor & renovation of water tank is required. Electricity problem in whole Pandeyat, there is no electricity connections in school. Renovation of toilets in schools, no drinking facilities in all schools. Tractor at B.Pan road are required in different wards of Pandeyat. Lighting stands/ tube wells are required in the pockets & during on national water resources day have to wait for long from hours to bring water Play ground for children of foster caring centres for females

People are not aware of the schools
 of different dept. So there is
 need of special camps in Pandeyat.
