Message

I am delighted to learn that the 3rd version of the much-acclaimed *Back to Village-3* (B2V3) programme, a unique and ambitious exercise of taking government to the doorstep of people is being organized from 2nd to 12th October 2020, across Jammu & Kashmir.

In June 2019, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir embarked on the *Back to Village* programme, which involved the visit of over 4000 Gazetted officers of J&K to every Panchayat and spending two days and a night there. It was also an opportunity to support and strengthen the newly constituted Panchayats. The programme was a huge success. Visiting officers were welcomed and feted by populace eager to share its troubles and travails with what they had perceived as an unresponsive administration. In fact such was the enthusiasm generated by the programme that the Hon'ble Prime Minister made a mention of it in his 'Man Ki Baat', calling it "a festival of development, public participation and public awareness."

Encouraged by the success of the programme, the government organized the *Back to Village-2* (B2V2) in November 2019. This time the focus was on ensuring that funds and functions devolved to the Panchayats were used without any bottlenecks and that beneficiary oriented schemes actually reach the last person in the queue. The Hon'ble Prime Minister again made mention of the programme in his Independence Day speech of 2020.

I believe the upcoming version of the *Back to Village-3* (B2V3) programme will be an attempt at a concentrated and determined developmental push in the region. The actual programme shall be preceded by a three week Jan Abhiyan (Awami Muhim) which shall focus on 3 concurrent and interconnected goals: Jan Sunvwai (Awami Sunwai) - Public grievances redressal, Adhikar Abhiyan (Muhim Barai-e-Haqooq) - Public Service Delivery and Unnat Gram Abhiyan (Dehi Taraqiyati Muhim) - Delivery of Development on ground.

I am confident that this unique effort shall earn the respect of the people of Jammu and Kashmir and that it will be remembered for long as a unique and sincere effort of the government to reach the doorsteps of the people.

II) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: Enhancement of Honorarium/wages of Asha workers/Anganwadi workers and regularization of daily wages of PHE and PDD. Shortage of electric poles and poor voltage quality at Chachihall and Guffarna was brought to my notice and I witnessed the same and found it true. Thus it is requested to consider these complaints on priority bases.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: 1. The Panchayat Krawah is scattered over an area of about 8 kms and so separate Panchayat for Chachihall may be created out of Krawah. 2. Separate filtration plants for Krawah and Chachihall exclusively along with upgradation of water pipelines and protection/maintenance of all six springs of Panchayat. 3. One Dispensary for Krawah, one for Chachihall exclusively for ST population, 2. Anganwadi workers Centre at Chachihall and one for Krawah (ward 7 Anpora). 4. Sanctioning of four new transformers of 25 kv at Anpora, Mit ward 3, Boudal mohalla ward 8, Sehall mohalla ward 9 along with upgradation of transformers from 10 kv to 25 kv at ward 10/11. Road from Chachihall to Mispora Khawda ward 10/11 about 2 kms.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions. (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.) = People are having great hopes of development after B2V1 and B2V2. But in B2V3 it was noticed that very few workers have been started so taken up so the people are sad and not willing to share their views and are not willing to participate in the B2V3 programme. Besides poor infrastructure with the shape of drinking water facilities, poor voltage due to low capacity transformers, rusted pipelines also enhances the sadness to the people of Panchayat. So it is requested to make people hopeful by resolving their issues to make Panchayat fully functional, would help in obviating the problems of the general public by transforming the implementation of schemes of various departments.
