

I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

Scarcity of drinking water has been the major issue raised by the public. Public has been demanding a Separate Water Supply Scheme for the village to overcome the problem of drinking water. This issue was vehemently taken by the women of the village in the Mahila Saba held during the visit.

II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

① → Establishment of a Separate Water-supply Scheme for the village has not been addressed by PHE (Tal Shakti Dept.)

② → Removal of encroachments of Pasture Land and Nalla Pahru is a major demand of for the public involving Revenue Dept and I & FC Dept.

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III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The visit has provided a peep into the problems faced by the villagers. During the visit, it was observed that there is enough scarcity of drinking water in the village. Hence Creation of a Separate Water Supply Scheme is the most important demand. Besides Nalla Pahru flowing through the village has been encroached upon. So there is a need to remove the encroachments by I & FC Dept in collaboration with Revenue Dept. Pasture Land encroached by land grabbers has to be reclaimed on priority.
