I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: Inadequate supply of drinking water and Electricity. Old HT/LT line works with holes at many spots. The old wooden poles are rotten and needs to be replaced with HT/LT line and more transformers are required to be installed as the existing transformers do not cater the need of the public. The water pipeline is damaged / leaked at many spots which also needs to be repaired and more reservoirs needs to be constructed in order to cater the need of the public. The blacktopping of the existing road has badly damaged and there is no side drain existing in the road to dispose off the rain water. There is no Health Care Centre in the G.P. The irrigation Canal (Kanal) is damaged and needs to be restored immediately in order to make the agriculture land cultivable for paddy crops.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: (1) Installation of Receiving Station. (2) Establishment of Medical Sub-Centre/Health Care centre. (3) Replacement of old rotten wooden poles and HT/LT line and installation of additional transformers. (4) Replacement/repairing of water supply pipelines and construction of additional reservoirs. (5) Restoration of irrigation Canal (Kanal) from Shalgubi to Guffarhasti (Kamalchihall). (6) Construction of Jucca drain on Chamabha Neel road from 1st to 3rd km. (7) Establishment of Agriculture/Horticulture/Anganwadi Centre in G.P.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.) Public services in this panchayat seem to be satisfactory. There are certain areas that can be improved in terms of public services. The Panchayat has ample potential in the field of Agricultural, Horticulture, Sheep/Animal husbandry & Fisheries which needs to be focussed it for the overall development of the panchayat. Panchayat functioning of this panchayat is satisfactory. Further progress can be made to make this group more organization fruitful for this panchayat for overall development.
