The needy and poor people of the Panchayat must be covered under PMAY scheme as no one is covered under this scheme in this Panchayat till date. The list of the beneficiaries has not been approved till date.

Besides this the list of leftout cases of the Panchayat for sanction of oldage pension, widow pension & physically handicapped pension is enclosed as in "Annexure B" was prepared during B₂V₃ programme.

During the visit of H/S Khari it was observed that the school building is not sufficient for running a high school only four class rooms are in good condition whereas rest of the building is unsafe & required reconstruction & repairment as the education is the basic need of human being.

During B₂V₃ Programme two works namely construction of road from Dei to GMS Dei & construction of playground were inaugurated.
