NOTES

The overall visit to the Panchayat was good. There were many public demands and complaints which needs proper ~~gathering~~ ^{in time bound manner} to build trust and raise the spirits of the public. Apart from major demands raised earlier there were few new demands and information that needs to be made available to the higher authorities. Some of these are: -

1. For Panchayat Ghar constable Sajpandi (Mehd. Sadiq Butti) has donated land but funds have to be made available. Also there is no road connectivity to the said land so it needs to be constructed as it is only 1 km from the Suroo stand Badaroo.
2. There is no playground and rooms for outdoor activity at Panchayat for which the said Sajpandi is ready to donate land for both of these.
3. The people living in lower Butti Mohalla (Kuchi Mohalla) are very poor and face difficulty when any family has a marriage function. The Sajpandi wants a Community hall constructed for which again land will be donated by the Sajpandi sb.
