Message

I am delighted to learn that the 3rd version of the much-acclaimed *Back to Village-3 (B2V3)* programme, a unique and ambitious exercise of taking government to the doorstep of people is being organized from 2nd to 12th October 2020, across Jammu & Kashmir.

In June 2019, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir embarked on the *Back to Village* programme, which involved the visit of over 4000 Gazetted officers of J&K to every Panchayat and spending two days and a night there. It was also an opportunity to support and strengthen the newly constituted Panchayats. The programme was a huge success. Visiting officers were welcomed and feted by populace eager to share its troubles and travails with what they had perceived as an unresponsive administration. In fact such was the enthusiasm generated by the programme that the Hon'ble Prime Minister made a mention of it in his "Man Ki Baat", calling it "a festival of development, public participation and public awareness."

Encouraged by the success of the programme, the government organized the *Back to Village-2 (B2V2)* in November 2019. This time the focus was on ensuring that funds and functions devolved to the Panchayats were used without any bottlenecks and that beneficiary oriented schemes actually reach the last person in the queue. The Hon'ble Prime Minister again made mention of the programme in his Independence Day speech of 2020.

I believe the upcoming version of the *Back to Village-3 (B2V3)* programme will be an attempt at a concentrated and determined developmental push in the region. The actual programme shall be preceded by a three week Jan Abhiyan (Awami Muhim) which shall focus on 3 concurrent and interconnected goals: Jan Sunwai (Awami Sunwai) - Public grievances redressal, Adhikar Abhiyan (Muhim Bar-e-Haqooq) - Public Service Delivery and Unnat Gram Abhiyan (Devi Taraqiyati Muhim) - Delivery of Development on ground.

I am confident that this unique effort shall earn the respect of the people of Jammu and Kashmir and that it will be remembered for long as a unique and sincere effort of the government to reach the doorsteps of the people.

Message

Jammu and Kashmir continues to witness a transformation of Panchayat Raj Institutions over time their constitution in 2018. Through the first of its kind initiative - 'Back to Village' and the Government's decision of deepening funds, functions and functionaries in PRAIs, grass root activation has flourished in the Union Territory. As a next step in this direction, the phase 2 of the Back to Village programme is being held from 2nd October to 12th October, 2021, which will give a deeper thrust to the institutionalisation of PRAIs.

While the first B2V focused on interaction and information on local needs, the second B2V focused on strengthening and institutionalising Panchayats, handholding the newly elected PRAIs and ensuring an attention and 100% coverage of individual beneficiary oriented schemes.

Further, local demands are being taken up through a three week long public outreach exercise-Jan Aamir-Nagari Yojana, with its three concurrent and interconnected goals of public grievances redressal, public service delivery and delivery of development on ground. B2V3 is also an occasion to assess government functioning and service delivery through an unprecedented proactive Government-PRAI interface.

I appeal to all Panchayat representatives as well as people to come forward and proactively participate in the program, thereby making governance more participatory, transparent and responsible.

I also urge the Deputy Commissioners to coordinate the visits of officers to various Panchayat mandals for better outcomes and ensure adherence to COVID SOPs while arranging various outreach activities.

I am confident that the people and officials alike will once again rise to the occasion and replicate the success of earlier B2V programmes.
