many issues, all of them ~~is~~ difficult to mention here but I think demands

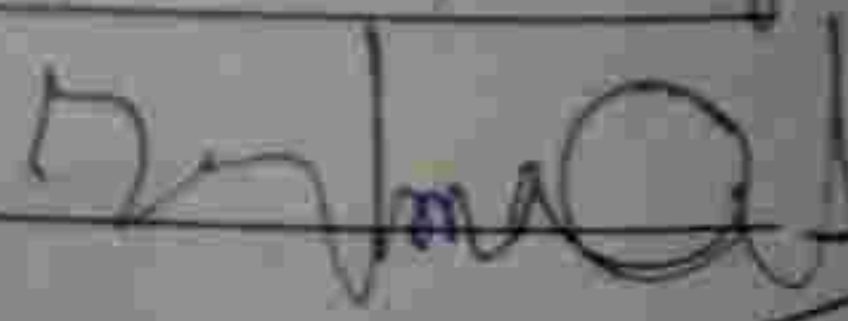
were genuine. ^{Even} There is ^{no} building for panchayat ^{up} in AGI AR - B. public
