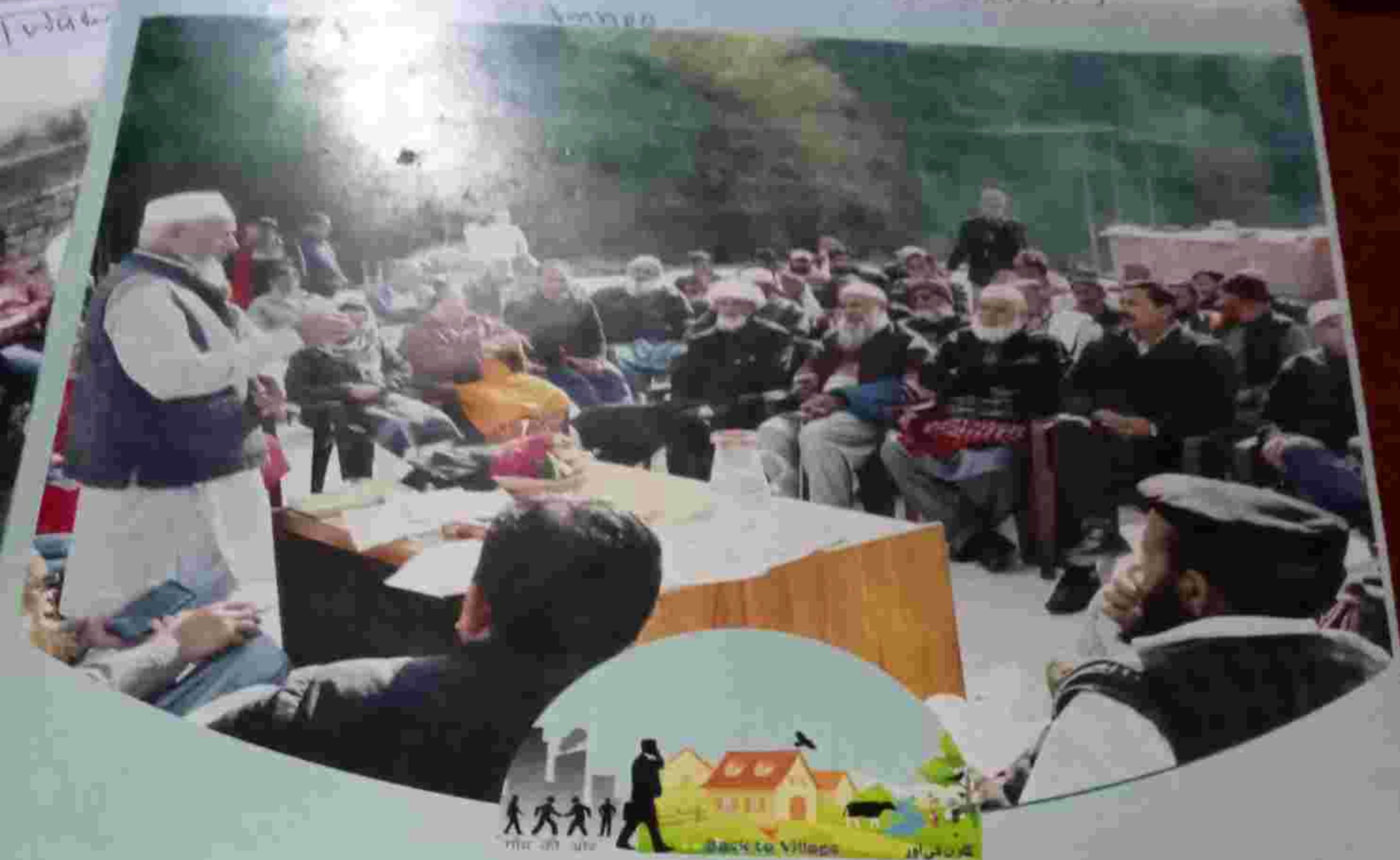

- I.
 1. Sh. water supply at Gaganwal Bannoo: Land was identified and tenders were passed but due to various reasons the project got stalled. Urgent attention needed to this end.
 2. bridge required on Main Road Bannoo near 1/2 to Mainuddin Mandi.
 3. Demand for Health sub-centre / Dispensary for Bannoo.
 4. Creation of a separate Patwari Halqa for Bannoo due to huge workload as a single Patwari catering to 14 remote villages thereby resulting in delay in revenue related work.
- II. Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
 1. Concrete lined wall on Gagan-Kaal (village irrigation canal) Bannoo branch of Gagan-Canal (under administrative control of Irrigation, Shopian) to safeguard against floods.
 2. Repairment of Road from main road Bannoo to Nagay Muballa Chhambanjār urgently needed.
 3. Upgradation of Electricity transmission lines, canals, drinking water pipelines, bundling on canals & road sides.

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III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

Majority of the problems and complaints highlighted and brought into the notice of govt. in earlier phases of Back to village remain yet to be addressed. Enthusiasm in people related to Back to Village Programme as witnessed in earlier phases of govt. has suffered a massive setback to failure of govt. to solve the problems of people in time. Unless grievances being made during the B2V Programme are redressed fully and in time, it will be difficult to make B2V a successful venture.

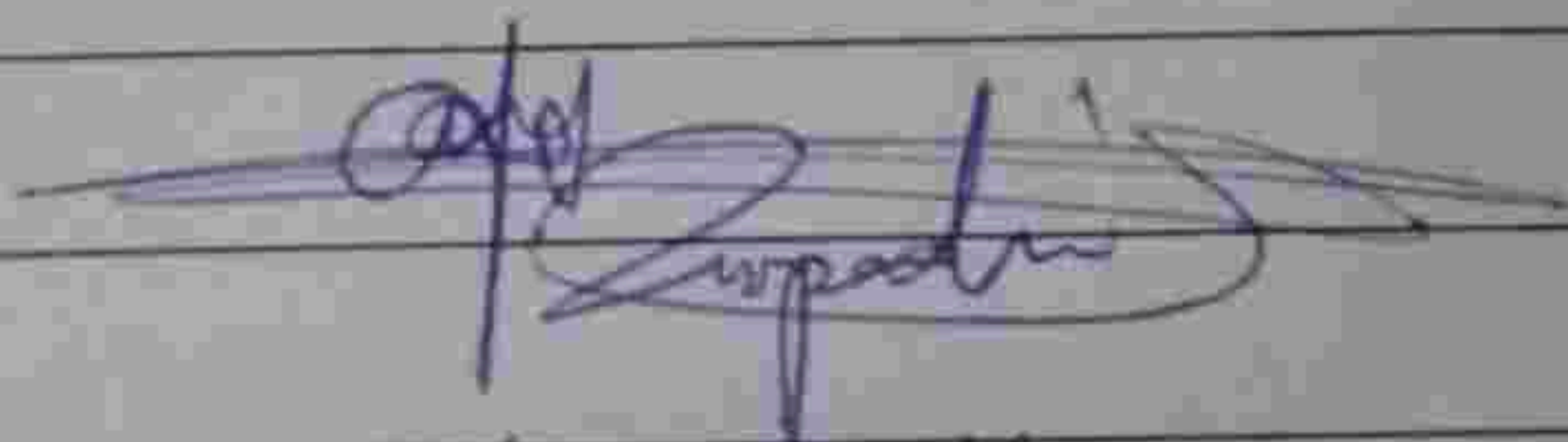
