-	Condition of the school building at M's Gauram is very poor. Immediate action in this regard needs to be taken. Further, there is no science teacher in the school. M's Gauram from last few years (one science teacher of this school post deployed and since other teachers are not available)
II	Major urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far.
1.	Provision of new Electric Poles and wires at various points of pondalga Haldia especially near the area of Janna, Mohal, Kanchana, New Transferring of Shimadella, Maladipada & Gauram needs to be installed.
2.	Water supply at Maladipada. Filteration plant for Haldia water in the Haldia is required.
3.	A separate ICDS centre & a Public Shop at Gauram. For primary school class- Gauram, Staff availability, the building further in all the schools of the Haldia, there is urgent need for separate girls toilet & a cooking room for mothers.
