Fungicides & pesticides provided to apple growers of the area this year were found sub-standard, as the major of the orchards were badly affected by fungal infections, resulting in low quality yield. General public demanded that in future the fungicides & pesticides be provided only after proper testing.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
2.	General public complained that different irrigation canals flowing through Dastager have been encroached at different locations, resulting in choking of the canals. God forbid in the event of any flash flood the gushing water can be devastating for residential areas. General public complained that despite of many verbal & written complaints the concerned department turned a deaf ear to the demands.

OVERALL ASSESSMENT OF VISIT AND SUGGESTIONS:

Back to Village Programme-3 has been organised particularly to fulfil demands put forth by general public in previous sessions i.e. B2V1 and B2V3. It also includes demands raised in 21 days long JAN ABYAN – AWAMI MUHIM. Back to village programme is people oriented but due to some unknown reasons the B2V3 programme has been organised in BDO office Shadimarg, far from general public. Since people of the Panchayat Halqa are connected with apple industry and are busy in harvesting the fruits, resulting in meagre participation of general public. Although the B2V3 programme has been conducted in a conducive atmosphere but due to absence of an elected Sarpanch, Panches and BDC chairman zeal and zest was missing as had been experienced in B2V1. Moreover lack of coordination between line departments and RDD has been observed. It is suggested that Panchayat Elections be held without any further delay. Further timing of the programme should be chosen outside the harvesting season and programme should be conducted within Panchayat Halqa.
