I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer.
→	4km (approx.) stretch which lies under the territory of P.F. camp need repairment and upgradation as lot of water losses in that stretch due to seepage and the required water for irrigating the crops is not available to the fields.
→	Not sufficient infrastructure is available for electric supply. Acute shortage of transformers, wires and poles due to which there always occur fluctuations of light.
→	Lack of mobile towers due to weak signals occurs frequently hence hinders the communication.
→	Redressal of issues of PMAY, Oldage, widow, PHE pensions should be resolved on priority.
→	There is not PHE connections available in the G.P. (as per locals).
→	Village roads need to be repaired.
→	Red tapism in revenue department creates huge problems for the locals (as per locals).
→	Dunkies needs to be maintained in rainy season.
→	Tubewell works commenced approx. four years back but not completed till date at kudwal.
