The main reason being Kawhar Bala Council of Schedule Tribe (ST) population with low literacy rate and people struggling for day to day livelihood by working on daily basis in neighbouring villages. I found following immediate step to be taken to put Kawhar Bala on the same frequency of development as the other villages are getting through. Presence of EOD is unclear therefore special focus needs to be provided on water supply. Some EOD work done in Kawhar Bala is almost 100% completed. Conservation and EOD truly need to constant protection and many places in Panchayat Talja.
