From 1980 to 1984, the number of people who had been in the United States for less than five years increased from 1.1 million to 1.5 million. This increase was due to a combination of factors, including a large influx of immigrants from Latin America and the Caribbean, and a smaller increase in the number of immigrants from Europe and Asia.


