Message

I am delighted to learn that the 3rd version of the much-acclaimed *Back to Village-3 (B2V3)* programme, a unique and ambitious exercise of taking government to the doorstep of people is being organized from 2nd to 12th October 2020, across Jammu & Kashmir.

In June 2019, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir embarked on the *Back to Village* programme, which involved the visit of over 4000 Gazetted officers of J&K to every Panchayat and spending two days and a night there. It was also an opportunity to support and strengthen the newly constituted Panchayats. The programme was a huge success. Visiting officers were welcomed and feted by populace eager to share its troubles and travails with what they had perceived as an unresponsive administration. In fact such was the enthusiasm generated by the programme that the Hon'ble Prime Minister made a mention of it in his "Man Ki Baat", calling it "a festival of development, public participation and public awareness."

Encouraged by the success of the programme, the government organized the *Back to Village-2 (B2V2)* in November 2019. This time the focus was on ensuring that funds and functions devolved to the Panchayats were used without any bottlenecks and that beneficiary oriented schemes actually reach the last person in the queue. The Hon'ble Prime Minister again made mention of the programme in his Independence Day speech of 2020.

I believe the upcoming version of the *Back to Village-3 (B2V3)* programme will be an attempt at a concentrated and determined developmental push in the region. The actual programme shall be preceded by a three week Jan Abhiyan (Awami Muhim) which shall focus on 3 concurrent and interconnected goals: Jan Sunvwai (Awami Sunwai) - Public grievances redressal, Adhikar Abhiyan (Muhim Barai-e-Haqooq) - Public Service Delivery and Unnat Gram Abhiyan (Dehi Taraqiyati Muhim) - Delivery of Development on ground.

I am confident that this unique effort shall earn the respect of the people of Jammu and Kashmir and that it will be remembered for long as a unique and sincere effort of the government to reach the doorsteps of the people.

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
	<p>Masses unanimously complained about deteriorated condition of the lake banks which was also evident during the visit of the undersigned. Basic health facilities viz non posting of male doctor in the PHC which is run in a rental accommodation without necessary facilities are lacking in the Panchayat. The undersigned identified a vacant Primary School building at Chiralipara, Nangan's which is presently not in use and the locals demanded for utilising the building for any purpose which may be beneficial for the locals.</p>
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
	<p>A bigger problem of drug menace amongst the youths highlighted earlier in the B2V1 and B2V2 is still unaddressed. The locals especially ladies insisted for redressal of the same. Locals are unaware about various schemes launched by the Government from time to time thus are unable to get benefits. Social welfare and ICDS dept's need to gear up and make awareness of these schemes among the locals for possible implementation on the ground.</p>
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	<p>The undersigned is of the opinion that the issues raised by the locals during interaction in the Gram Sabha could be addressed by the concerned departments provided the dept. shows seriousness in resolving the issue. However, a suitable place in the area needs to be identified at the earliest for setting up of a playground for which the youth of the area laid emphasis. This will engage youth of the area to participate in sports activities and will not only build their health and physique but will make them mentally strong besides keeping them away from the menace of drugs.</p>
