JK REGP

To harness and direct the energy and enthusiasm of the youth of the I/T for establishment of the productive enterprise in rural industrial sector and to create employment opportunities (rural) as well as urban areas of the I/T, a new credit linked subsidy programme namely J&K Rural Employment Generation Programme (JKREGP) is proposed. The programme will

- be implemented by J&K Khadi and Village Industries Board and the subsidy will be routed through J&K Bank for eventual distribution to the beneficiaries in their bank accounts. The implementing agency will associate Office of the concerned District Development Commissioners, Lead district managers, Districts of Industries, Financing banks, Entrepreneurship Development Institute and NRI's Kandiya and other relevant bodies in the implementation of the scheme, especially in the area of utilization of beneficiaries, area specific viable projects and providing training in entrepreneurship development.

Objectives

- To harness and develop the entrepreneurial skills among the rural unemployed youth of the I/T
- To inculcate the bank finance for establishment of Village Industries sector of the I/T in rural areas
- To generate employment opportunities in rural areas of the I/T through setting up of new self employment ventures/projects/village industries enterprises.
- To increase the wage earning capacity of persons/workers and contribute to increase in the growth rate of rural employment.

Scope and Nature of Financial Assistance

- In maximum case of the government admissible under manufacturing/agriculture/horticulture & allied sector shall be Rs. 25 lakh.
- In maximum case of the government admissible under service/retailing activity shall be Rs. 10 lakh. However, under rural and public transport sector, the project cost shall be admissible to the upper ceiling of Rs.10 lakh.
- Project reports for the beneficiaries shall be prepared by Rural Industrial Consultants service centres (RIC's), J&K, ITO, DIC or any Government owned or private agency registered with J&K, KVIC.
