- ② The distance of land between forest department & various different villages in the C. District of J.P. is too much. Schools have more than 15. with but only 10 teachers are working there hence compromising the quality of P.M. children; officers from education dept. should visit the area to rectify all such problems.
- ③ Wild animals are roaming, hence poses threat to lives & property, hence fencing to the nearby forest.
- ④ Panchayat committees lack basic infrastructure facilities, like chairs, furnishing etc. the concerned department may take account of it.
- ⑤ Lack of sports stadium is one of the major issues. As the land is available for this concerned department should be directed to initiate work on it.
- ⑥ As people are unaware about most of Govt. Schemes, hence special events may be organised to educate people about various Govt. Schemes.
