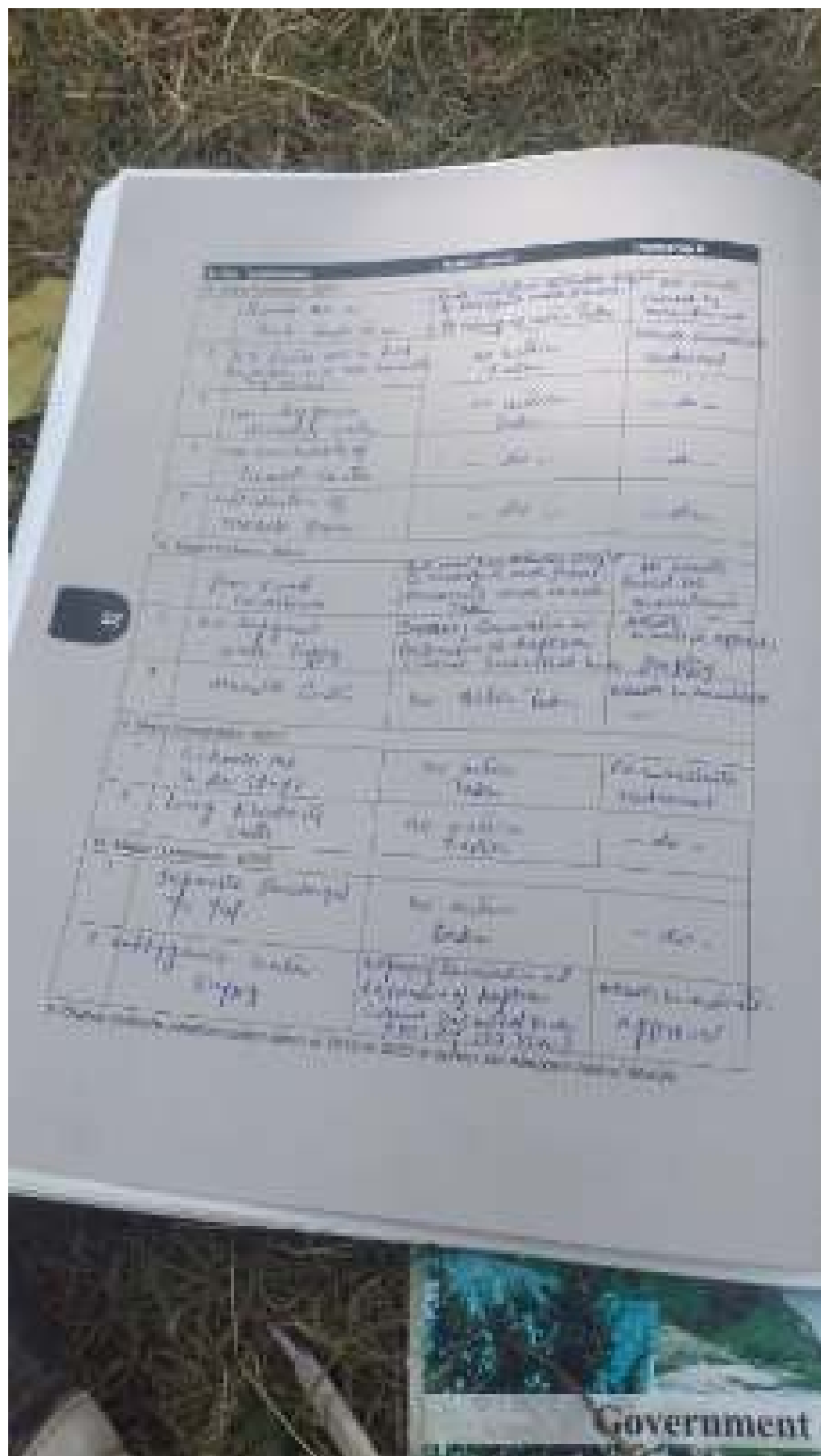

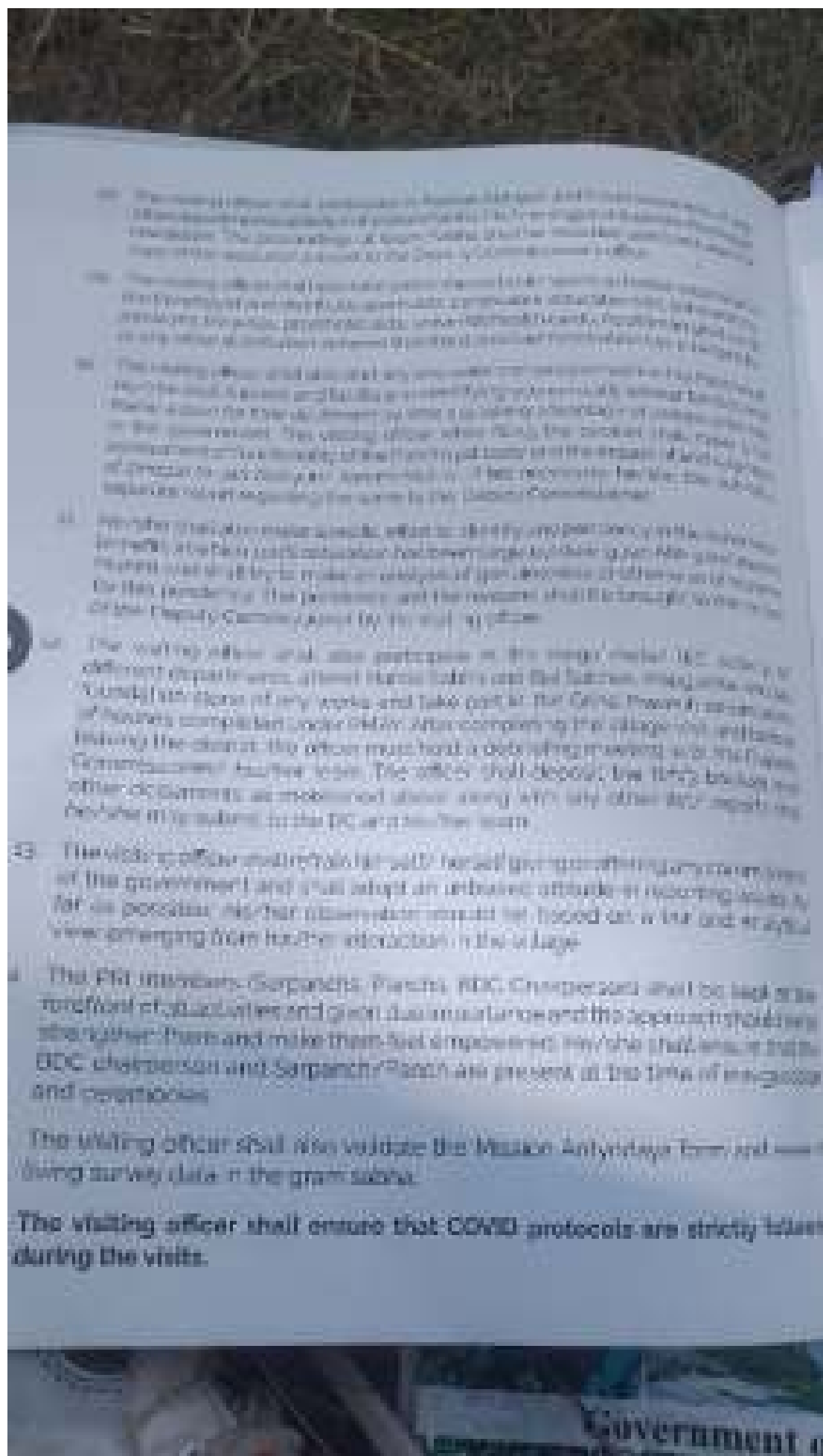

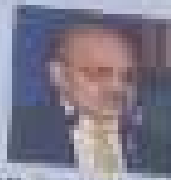

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At June 2004, the Government of Liberia and Adams announced the release of 10,000 prisoners, which included the vast 97,000-100,000 suspected rebels of AMU, former Parliament and speaking unit that had a reputation of war crimes including the killing and maiming of its enemy or targeted civilians.
